### KEYHOLE RACE -RULES

A lane 12m long x1.2m wide is marked with 6m circle in one end of the lane.

The starting line is at the end of the lane opposite the circle.

Another line is made 6m before reaching the starting line, this is a timed event and starts at the starting line entering the lane.

The rider must have his horse inside the back line and the horse must stop his forward motion before starting the race.

He then has 6m to start the horse before time begins at the entry of the lane.

Competitor rides down the lane turning inside the circle and returning down the lane.

Time starts and stops upon entering and leaving the lane.

Riders will be disqualified if a horse steps on or over the line.

If a horse steps back across the first line, an additional stop of his forward motion shall be required in the 6 metre zone.

After the additional crossing of the first line, 30 seconds will be allowed to enter the lane.

NB. The 6m line is to create a 6m zone and does not have to be drawn all of the way across the arena. The rider may enter the zone at any place.

**Three Judges will be used.**

## SECTION 1 HORSES

**INDEMNITY AND WAIVER:** when competitors have completed an Insurance waiver, a wrist band with ID No. will be issued.

**No competitor will be allowed into the ring without an ID Number.**

Names of horses will be required. Any incidents/accidents will need to be reported and recorded. Names and witnesses will be required.

Ring Office will be open for early entry tickets from 5.30 pm to 7.30 pm Friday

**ENTRY FEE:** \$4 unless otherwise stated.

Entry Tickets at Ring Office on day of show. Pairs entry fee \$4 per pair.

Nominations for Jumping, Sporting are to be made at Ring Office and close prior to the start of the event.

**PRIZEMONEY:** \$12 first prize, \$8 second, \$4 third unless otherwise stated. All prize money will be paid at Ring Office after the Grand Parade on Saturday and at the conclusion of events on Sunday, upon presentation of signed prize cards & Grand Parade entry ticket. **(Please note all Competitors must enter the Grand Parade where they'll be given a ticket to enable them to collect prize money.)** Prizes not collected by the close of Show on Sunday may be forfeited. Prizes won't be posted. Pairs prizes will be shared as is the entry fee.

**REGISTERED CLASSES:** Are Led unless stated otherwise. Horses are required to be registered/recorded in appropriate studbook. Registration papers are to be shown on request, and will be required when measuring takes place.

**HEIGHT CLASSES:** Are led unless otherwise stated. Horse owners are required to be in possession of a height certificate. Place-getters will be checked by stewards when prizes are awarded. Prizes will only be awarded if certificates are presented with correct height for the class.

- Accepted:
1. Official EFA Life or Annual Certificate.
  2. Official EFA Annual Certificate.
  3. Current Height Certificate obtained from Group 13 Show.
  4. Height Certificate in all classes EFA Certificate prevails.

**DISTRICT EVENTS:** Horse & Rider must be domiciled within Coffs Harbour City.

**NOVICE EVENTS:** Horses must not have won a first prize at any show.

**INTERMEDIATE EVENTS:** Horses must not have won a championship or four first prizes at any Show.

**STALLIONS:** Not eligible to compete in ridden classes unless specified.

**GENERAL:** Only Judges, Stewards and Competitors in the class being judged will be allowed in the ring. Competitors in each class must report to the Judge within three minutes of the final call for that class. No more competitors in that class will be admitted to the ring and judging will proceed. All competitors compete at their own risk and must be wearing an ID band on their wrist.

**RING PROGRAM: NO undue delays to the ring program will be allowed.** In the event of two rings clashing, competitors will be obliged to decide in which event they wish to compete.

**MARSHALLING AREA:** All competitors are to assemble in the designated marshalling area and under the instruction of gatekeeper or announcer are to proceed directly into ring.

**BITUMEN ROADWAYS AND ENTRY/EXIT LANE** are to remain free of horses at all times.

**PROHIBITED DRUGS:** Horses shall perform on their merits without the aid of drugs. It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure that no horse enters the ring under the influence of any prohibited drug.

**HEAD PROTECTION:** Approved safety helmets must be worn by all competitors aged 17 years and under and are recommended for all competitors in ridden events.

**HORSE STABLES:** Concrete block stables are available for rental at **\$6** per night or **\$15** whole show **FOR THE WEEKEND . Rental is payable by 17TH APRIL 2010**

Allotted stabling cannot be changed because of uncontrollable horses. The committee reserves the right to request removal from the grounds of any animal which cannot be controlled.

Allocations for travelers will be made as payment is received. The remaining stables will be allocated to locals after this date in order of receipt. Camping fees are required to be paid with stable bookings.

Allocations will only be made if camping fees are received.

Competitors staying overnight outside the grounds will have fees refunded at time of departure after proof of accommodation.

**CAMPING ON GROUNDS:** Camping fee of **\$10** per person payable by competitors wishing to stay on the grounds overnight.

Competitors will receive a "paid camping" voucher which must be placed inside the windscreen of their vehicle.

Competitors are advised to pay for camping when booking stables.

**MARSHALLING AREA & ACCESS LANE** are to remain clear of vehicles at all times.

**VEHICLES STRICTLY PROHIBITED** from parking under trees.

**Owners breaching this order will have their cars towed and be liable for fee.**

**GROUND ENTRY: Save money with "Show 3 day pass"** available on application. **\$38** Double (2Adults,4Children) or **\$20** Single (1Adult, 2Children) Individual **\$15**.

Pre-bought passes available to midday May 7, 2010 after which normal daily admission applies.

**Daily admission:** Adult **\$12**, Child/Senior **\$8**

**VEHICLE ACCESS:** for competitors is via rear of soccer field.

Access road around arena is closed during the show. (see map-separate download)

**CAMPING AREAS:** Horses are not permitted in camping Area 1.

Electric fences are not permitted on the Showground.

**ELECTRIC LEADS:** Must be mounted overhead. Exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the showground will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor.

**SELF REGULATION IS REQUIRED:** Competitors taking horses onto bitumen roadways, or into camping area 1, avoiding paying camping fees, using stables not allocated to them or causing inconvenience to other competitors will **not** be permitted to exhibit in the Ring Centre.

**HORSE STABLES:** Concrete block stables are available for rental at **\$6 per stable per night or \$15 for 3 nights**. Allocation for travellers will be made as payment is received until April 17, after which time, remaining stables will be allocated to locals or travellers in order of receipt. Bookings will not be held unless payment follows immediately. Allotted stabling cannot be changed because of uncontrollable horses. The Committee reserves the right to request the removal from the grounds of any animal which cannot be controlled. **CAMPING ON GROUNDS:** A camping fee of **\$10 per person per night** is payable by competitors wishing to stay on the grounds overnight. Competitors will receive a "PAID CAMPING" ticket which must be placed on the vehicle's dashboard and be clearly visible at all times. Powered sites are limited & campers are advised to pay for camping when booking stables. A limited number of Stallion & Miniature Horses can be stabled.
