GENERAL CONDITIONS

Special by-laws:

- Only those competitors wearing a wrist band indicating a waiver has been signed will be accepted
- Unshod Horses, Galloways and Ponies will be allowed to enter all classes.
- Only competitors, their attendants holding horses and officials of the show shall be allowed to enter the ring enclosure.
- All exhibits not ready for judging will be disqualified even though the event (from any cause) is held later than shown.
- Every endeavour will be made to avoid the judging of two classes concurrently in which
 one exhibitor may be interested. The Committee, however, cannot accept any
 responsibility if the judging time happens to conflict with one or more classes or events.
- A maiden shall be a Horse, Galloway or Pony that has never won a first prize in any
 agricultural show. An exhibit, which has won in a pairs and/or fours class, is still
 considered a maiden or a novice as the case may be for a single class.
- A ringmaster must not compete at his or her own show.
- Any rider who has competed in Ring 4 cannot compete in any other ring other than sporting ring
- An intermediate hack is one that has not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an individual ridden hack class at any Royal show including the RNA Bathurst, Toowoomba and Launceston Royals or Hoty
- The ringmaster reserves the right to refuse entry to the ring to anyone deemed to be under the influence of alcohol or any other drugs.
- Riding coats are to be worn by the discretion of the rider.

Championship Awards: The first prize winner in all riding classes and hack classes is eligible to compete for their respective Championship. In awarding the Reserve Champion the first prize winners in all rider classes and single hack classes, other than the competitor to which the Champion was awarded, shall be eligible to compete along with the second prize winner in the class in which the Champion was awarded the first prize.

All rules pertaining to the horse events may be viewed at the Horse Secretary's Office.

ALL COMPETITORS COMPETE IN RING EVENTS AT THEIR OWN RISK

- Stewards to be at secretary office by 8am
- Prize money will be paid by the Ring Steward on the day of the show
- Entry Fees \$2.00 to be paid at horse secretary office
- Waivers to be signed and wrist band acquired before competing
- All ring classes (breeds) can be split where needed.
- Stallion classes can be added to program if needed.
- LOCAL EVENTS: All horses, galloways and ponies competing in local events both rider and horse must have resided within the Warrumbungle Shire Council and must have been on the property of the exhibitor for three months prior to the date of the show and stabled in the area.
- Supreme Champion led horse of the show (Open to all led champions)
- Supreme Champion Open Hack trophy donated, only the first champion in each ring is eligible.
- Supreme Champion Hunter Hack trophy donated
- Binnaway P.A.H & I Association Inc. will not be responsible for any accidents that may be caused through or by any exhibit and it shall be a condition of each entry that exhibitors shall hold the Association blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from such accidents.
- Competitors must compete in headwear applicable to the event in which they are competing in per EFA guidelines.
- "Headwear must comply with currently recognised standards"
- Stallions are required to be tied and collared at all times.
- Open Hacks and Hunter Hacks can only compete in one section.
- Newcomer is a horse that has not been shown before under saddle, before the 1st January 2016 and is to be ridden in a snaffle bit.
- SHOW HUNTER: Is for hacks, Galloways & ponies 3 years and over. If any hack, Galloway or Pony
 compete in any Open hack class they are not eligible to compete in the show hunter or vice versa.
- Competitors who compete in ring 5 may not compete in any other ring other than ring 6
- All mini, small and little horses are to be registered with a recognised miniature association
- Mini ring will be run under MHSA rules
