

RECIPE FOR ITEM 27 and 27(A) (Chocolate Cake made by a male)

RICH CHOCOLATE CAKE

185g butter
2 teaspoons vanilla essence
1¾ cups castor sugar
3 eggs
2 cups self-raising flour
2/3 cup cocoa
1 cup water

Grease a deep round cake pan (max 23cm), line with paper; grease paper.

Combine butter, essence, sugar, eggs, sifted flour and cocoa and water in a large bowl, beat on low speed with electric mixer until ingredients are combined. Increase speed to medium, beat for about 3 minutes or until mixture is smooth and changed colour. Spread into prepared pan.

Bake in slow-moderate oven for about 1½ hours

MAKE SURE YOUR OVEN IS NOT TOO HOT! Stand 5 minutes before turning on to wire rack to cool.

- For Collections, different varieties are preferable, but if that is not possible, different colours at least. Make sure when presenting Collections that your vase is large enough, and mark which side is the viewing side. Use a vase which is suitable to display your flowers, and do not overcrowd.
- Mixed can be one variety, but must consist of buds and open flowers.




