<u>MEASUREMENT:</u> RAS measurements will be accepted only. It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure that horses are entered in the correct height classes. The Committee reserves the right to measure any exhibit. A horse measuring service will be provided at the Show – please see **Mr Robert Turner.**

NOVICE: is a horse that has not won a Champion at any Agricultural Show or first at any Royal Show.

INTERMEDIATE: is a horse that has not won a first at any Royal Show.

STALLIONS: cannot compete in any led or hack classes except where stated and must be handled by a person 17 years or over.

ALL COMPETITORS COMPETE AT THEIR OWN RISK AND MUST SIGN A WAIVER FORM BEFORE COMPETING.

PIC NUMBERS MUST BE PROVIDED WITH ENTRY.

Stewards reserve the right to alter the programme in any way at any time.

Classes will not be held up for competitors who are competing in another ring, competitors must choose which ring they wish to compete in. Competitors who are late may be refused entry.

Jumping events run under EA Rules.

Correct footwear and properly secured helmets which comply with Australian/European helmet standards are to be worn at all times by all competitors.
