

# Emergency Animal Disease Action Plan (EADAP)

## Purpose

Outlines the actions to be taken if a suspected emergency animal disease is detected during the Show.

## Immediate Actions

1. Isolate affected animal(s) and companions. 2. Notify the Show Veterinarian immediately. 3. Contact District Veterinarian and EAD Hotline (1800 675 888). 4. Restrict movement of other livestock and remove unnecessary personnel from livestock areas.

## Roles & Responsibilities

Chief Steward: Coordinate response and communication. Biosecurity Officer: Liaise with authorities and manage quarantine areas. Veterinarian: Examine animals and advise on next steps.

## Recordkeeping

Complete an Animal Incident Report for any suspected or confirmed disease cases. Retain all related documentation.

## Communication

Ensure all staff, stewards, and exhibitors are briefed on procedures. Provide regular updates during any incident.
