An excursion to your local Agricultural Show provides a valuable, real-world extension to classroom learning. It gives students hands-on exposure and opportunities to engage with people across many sectors of the agricultural industry.

With the introduction of Agriculture / Ag Technologies for Years 7-8 (in many curricula), all students will undertake units focused on innovation, systems thinking, coding, automation, and new technologies transforming the agricultural supply chain.

At an Agricultural Show students can engage in project based learning including participating in competitions and designing an entry or display.
