Bonalbo Show YOUNG FARMERS CHALLENGE Competition

The Young Farmers Challenge competition is open to teams of four people, teams must have at least one representative from each gender.

The winning senior team will be eligible to compete in the Group final held later in the year. The challenge provides the opportunity for young farmers to demonstrate their expertise in a series of on-farm challenges showcasing the depth of knowledge and technical skills required in agriculture today. These challenges can be anything from animal handling to fencing, driving tractors, putting out fires, first aid, heavy lifting and transport challenges.

The event will be held near the Bar and BBQ following the Official Opening of the Show.

EXHIBITORS AND COMPETITORS GUIDE

Closing dates for entries will be strictly observed and no late entries will be accepted.

The judges' decision in all classes shall be final.

Entry details must be completed before competing.

Drug testing may be carried out at this Show. Any competitor found to have breached the ASC disputes and disciplinary regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee.

The committee's decision in all matters of dispute shall be final.

Stallions cannot compete in riding and hack classes unless otherwise stated in the schedule.

RISK WARNING: Bonalbo Show as an affiliated member of the Agricultural Societies Council of New South Wales advises exhibitors and competitors in all sections that the participation, including passive participation, in events or activities at an agricultural show contains elements of risk, both obvious and inherent; and that they agree to participate entirely at their own risk and the Society is not responsible for any injury, damage or loss sustained by an exhibitor or competitor.

All competitors must complete and sign the waiver form (located on the Bonalbo Show website) and obtain a wristband prior to competing. Wristbands must be worn at all times or competitors will be asked to leave the competition area.

IMPORTANT: Please note that a competitor cannot submit a fillable PDF form to a Show Society via email. The forms are only valid when there is a physical signature present on it. The form must be printed, brought to the show and signed on the day.

PIC numbers: a Property Identification Code is mandatory for all properties carrying livestock. In accordance with ASC guidelines every exhibitor bringing livestock to the show will be required to list each animal being shown together with the PIC for the property from which it has come on the Waiver form before competing.

Health Status: Vaccination against the Hendra virus is not mandatory, however Bonalbo Show Society strongly supports the voluntary vaccination of horses. All exhibitors declare to the best of their knowledge that their horse is healthy and fit to be shown. A Horse Health Declaration form must be completed and submitted.

Electric Fences (Electrified Tape) for temporary enclosures for horses on Showgrounds: use of electric fencing is not permitted at the Bonalbo Show.

Interstate border crossing: competitors travelling from interstate to participate in events at Bonalbo Showgrounds are reminded that it is their obligation to comply with the relevant requirements for livestock movements and border crossings. 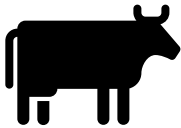
